

Decisions made since 23/3/2020

**Planning:**

- (a) 20/00666/HOU 5 Kestrel Close  
Erection of a single storey rear extension.  
EPC response: No objection
- (b) 20/00736/HOU Fir View, Beacon Hill Road  
Erection of a single storey rear extension following demolition of existing single storey rear projection.  
EPC response: No objection
- (c) 20/00265/HOU The Shannon, Church Lane  
Erection of a two storey side extension following demolition of existing detached garage and partial demolition of existing side projection creation of a 1 metre high retaining wall – consultation by HDC via email on amended plans  
EPC response: to confirm its original objection which was that the parish council objects to the application due to the proposed extension not being in keeping with the existing house to such an extent that it appears to be a separate dwelling, that the ridge height is too high and a lack of parking being identified following the loss of the garage.

**Administration:**

- (1) Approval for leaflet to deliver to all residents re support available during self isolation, including payment of printing costs.
- (2) Applications to Lloyds to set up internet banking.
- (3) That the Chairman and Clerk be authorised to make electronic payments whilst waiting for another councillor to be set up for internet banking.
- (4) Consideration of quotes for new net for the tennis court, supplier appointed and net installed. Subsequent approval to pay the invoice.
- (5) The working from home allowance for the Clerk increased to £26 a month (shared with Winchfield Parish Council) in line with the increase announced by HMRC.
- (6) To give a grant to the Crondall and Ewshot Pump Group to enable them to supply hot meals to older and vulnerable residents.
- (7) To not give approval to sign a memorandum of understanding with the Hart Response Hub regarding the provision of volunteer services whilst social distancing and self-isolation are in place. It was felt that the agreement did not fit the local circumstances. The parish council could not commit to carrying out all the duties as these were being carried out by volunteers in the community which was working well.
- (8) Receipt of the Internal Audit Report.
- (9) To authorise Cllr Taylor to purchase flowers etc to make hanging baskets for the Village Hall and to re-pot the planters in the village.
- (10) To authorise Fleet Town Council to appoint a parish representative to the Hart District Council Recovery Board.

(11) Approval to purchase and install a no parking sign for the top of the Bridle Path. Cllr Bredin confirmed that the land owner gives approval.

(12) To approve Kompan to carry out work in the play area to address the issues raised in the annual play area inspection including the replacement of the bearings on 2x spinners.

(13) To authorise Kompan to carry out an interim play area inspection in or around November 2020.
